Dear Clubs

Our thoughts are with each of you who have been impacted by Tropical Cyclone Alfred in recent days.

Football Queensland is pleased to confirm that no Wide Bay clubs are yet to report any damage or flooding. If your club has sustained damage or flooding in recent days, please [complete the club damage report form](#) on FQ's Disaster Recovery Hub as soon as it is possible and safe to do so.

FQ will work directly with any impacted clubs to accommodate the rescheduling or relocation of fixtures as necessary on a case-by-case basis.

Football Queensland can also confirm the closure of Martens Oval and the Fraser Coast Sports Precinct until this Wednesday, 12 March due to water on the fields.

An inspection will be completed at Federation Park first thing tomorrow to determine if the closure of the venue will be necessary before an update is provided to clubs and participants.

Football Queensland will continue to work closely with any Wide Bay clubs impacted by the recent weather event and encourages clubs to visit the [Disaster Recovery Hub](#) on the FQ website to view important updates on grants and funding support as they become available.
