Football Queensland has confirmed the Club Convention topics for the upcoming inaugural Queensland Football Convention on Saturday, 2 November and Sunday, 3 November 2024 at the Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre.

Over the two days, the Queensland Football Convention will offer specialised sessions for clubs, coaches, and referees, each featuring leading national and international speakers and panellists who will provide valuable insights and practical knowledge on key topics for advancing the game.

For attending club representatives and committee members, FQ has designed targeted sessions addressing critical topics essential for the growth and success of our clubs.

The following club focused sessions will be presented based on the themes of 'Growth,' 'Sustainability,' and 'Technology,' covering the following areas:
