

MATCH REVIEW PANEL

THURSDAY 20 JUNE 2024

On Thursday 20 June 2024, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider an incident arising from Round 15 of the NPL Men competition.

Brisbane City vs Moreton City Excelsior - Joseph Scott (Moreton City Excelsior)

The MRP considered an incident involving Joseph Scott of Moreton City Excelsior on or around the 82^{nd} minute of Moreton City Excelsior's NPL Men match against Brisbane City on Sunday 16 June.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Scott was issued with a direct Red Card by the Referee.

The MRP determined that Scott committed the offence of 'R1 02-01 Attempting to gain possession of the ball using excessive force'. The minimum sanction for the offence is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional match.

The MRP confirmed that Scott will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction for the offence.

Sunshine Coast Wanderers vs Redlands United - Peter Klaassen (Redlands United)

The MRP considered an incident involving Peter Klaassen of Redlands United on or around the 71st minute of Redlands United's NPL Men match against Sunshine Coast Wanderers on Sunday 16 June.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Klaassen was issued with a direct Red Card by the Referee.

The MRP determined that Klaassen committed the offences of 'R2 01-01 Excessive conduct when the ball is not in play or playing distance' & 'R6 02-01 Using language and/or gestures directed at another person'. The minimum sanction for the two offences is three (3) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus two additional matches.

The MRP confirmed that Klaassen will serve a suspension of three (3) matches, being the minimum sanction for the offence.
